## CORRECTIONS TO RECONNAISSANCE LEVEL HISTORIC RESOURCES SURVEY COMPILED BY HISTORIAN VIRGINIA SCHORADT

- 1. PAGE 5....Lena Cemetery does not have a 19<sup>th</sup> Century cast iron fence.
- 2. PAGE 7....In addition to the mill in Garrattsville, Myer's Mill still survives and is now a residence.
- 3. PAGE 13.....Footnote 2....Hilda Watrous was believed to have been at Syracuse University not SUNY Oneonta.
- 4. PAGE 20.....Additional Mill location-Barton's Mill located at Williams Rd and Co. Hwy. 12.
- 5. PAGE 23.....Victory Warren didn't die. He went bankrupt and reportedly he and his family went to Canada.
- 6. PAGE 24.....No mention that there was a tannery on Pegg Road in the hamlet of New Lisbon. (Later it was a cheese factory).
- 7. PAGE 29.....Footnote 38....should be Hartwick College, Rural Sociology Course.
- 8. PAGE 31.....Footnote 49....should be Hartwick College, not SUNY Oneonta. Myer's Mill not listed with mills.
- 9. PAGE 34.....Question of the difference in eligibility and that received in PASNY grant.
- 10. PAGE 48.....Pegg Road Barn---built earlier as dances were held there in the late 40's. Barn was built by Snethens (didn't go with 830 Pegg Rd. Property).
- 11. PAGE 49-51...Schoolhouse corrections—No #5 (Newton)-was abandoned and pupils went to Lena #4. #12 is not on Gross Road, but at Naylor's Corner (Gross Rd & Co. Hwy 12 corner), Jones Road schoolhouse is #6 and #11 the addition was originally the wood shed.
- 12. PAGE 53-54....Cemetery corrections---Cemetery on Myer's Mill Road is Smith Cemetery. The Gledhill Cemetery on St. Hwy. 51 is just below Garrattsville, not in Stetsonville. The cemetery in Stetsonville is located on St. Hwy. 51 nearer Stetsonville, opposite of the Parson residence, behind barns, closer to the Butternut Creek. The cemetery listed as Gardnertown is actually Falls Bridge, aka "Old Mt. Vision" and is on County Hwy. 11. The Garratt Monument location also has a gravestone for Mr. Richard Garratt. The Gardnertown cemetery is off Gardnertown Road on the Hohensee property. Buck Cemetery is located on Miller Road.
- 13.PAGE 55....225 Allen Road--were wood, not pressed mineral shingles; has been renovated back to Federal period.
- 14. PAGE 56....1115 County Hwy. 14—barns belong to log house property.
- 15. PAGE 65....271 Texas Road is a Springhouse.
- 16.PAGE 69....687 County Hwy. 14—Old house town down. New house in Federal style built in 2000.
