**NEW LISBON TOWN BOARD—SEPTEMBER 28, 2021—NEW HIGHWAY GARAGE PROPOSAL  
and 2022 TENTATIVE BUDGET MEETING**

Present: Supervisor Edward Lentz, Councilman Bill Whitaker, Councilman Brian Ryther, Councilwoman Flo Loomis, Councilwoman Nancy Martin-Mathewson, Hwy. Supt. Donald Smith, Town Clerk Charlene Wells, Resident Ryan Wing

The meeting started at 7:10 PM with Councilman Brian Ryther going through a brief summary of the new highway garage proposal. With only one resident present, questions were answered and the Board went on to the Budget.

The Board reviewed the 2022 Tentative Budget as prepared by Supervisor Edward Lentz. The Board made several adjustments. The Board discussed increasing the medical insurance buyout from \$2200.00 per year to \$4400.00 per year. Those taking the buyout option receive a smaller benefit and by increasing the amount to \$4400.00 it will be fairer and still save the Town money. With the carry over from previous years of unused increases, Supervisor Edward Lentz did not think we will need to do an override of the tax cap law.

The Board will hold its' last presentation on the New Highway Garage proposal at 7:00 PM on October 12, 2021. A flyer with the project information and a sample ballot will be mailed to registered voters prior to the meeting.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Nancy Martin-Mathewson, seconded by Councilwoman Flo Loomis and carried 5 Ayes/ 0 Nays to adopt the revised 2022 Tentative Budget as the 2022 Preliminary Budget and to hold a Public Hearing on it at 7:30 PM on Tuesday, October 12, 2021.

With no further business, a motion was made by Councilwoman Flo Loomis, seconded by Councilman Brian Ryther and carried 5 Ayes/ 0 Nays to adjourn at 8:40 PM.
