

Otsego County 2025 Rabies Vaccination Free Clinics For All Pet Dogs, Cats & Ferrets



PET OWNERS: Compulsory vaccination is required for all dogs and cats in Otsego County. The incidence of confirmed positive rabies cases of raccoon rabies continues in Otsego County. Every dog and cat three (3) months of age or older is required to be vaccinated.

- Previous rabies Vaccination Certificate <u>must</u> be presented to receive a 3 year booster (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- ➤ The vaccine being used gives 1 year protection for domestic dogs and cats receiving their <u>first</u> vaccination and 3 years protection for domestic dogs and cats receiving a booster.
- > Domesticated ferrets require vaccination each year.
- Even pet dogs and cats that stay indoors must be vaccinated.
- NYS law requires all dogs to be licensed. A license will not be issued for a time period extending beyond the date of the dogs rabies certificate.
- ➤ It is NYS law that any unvaccinated pet exposed to a rabid or suspected rabid animal be euthanized or quarantined for 6 months at **owners**' expense.
- It is NYS law that any unvaccinated pet that bites may be confined for ten days at a facility at owners' expense.
